They also do decent damage to your vehicle; that’s why you need to have hull reinforcement and a repair tool.Once you reach the underwater islands, you will need to head straight down until you reach the bottom of the underwater island. This is very important to know, as descending further than the crush depth will, as the name suggests, start to crush the vehicle. The locations in which it is most abundant include: Mountains (near the hot vents and watch out for Reaper Leviathans) Mountains Caves Jellyshroom Cave (use a scanner room) The other biomes in which Magnetite can be found (and some of them are a bit scarier) are as follows: Blood Kelp Zone Inactive Lava Zone Lava Castle Lost River (Bone Fields, Ghost Forest, Tree Cove) Sea Treader’s Path Uses In Crafting There are several items it is used to craft, and it includes item modifications as well. The biomes let players take a break from exploring the ocean’s depth, though they come with their own set of problems. Magnetite is used to craft a variety of items, which is why you need to know where it is located in Subnautica.

The areas can be distinguished by their visual designs, which is handy as there is no map feature in the game. It’s able to walk on the ocean floor with its large, human-like legs, offering a different perspective on underwater travel in the game. You make them with the modification station, not the vehicle upgrade console and there are no fragments to find. It is why this is a must-have resource once you have found your footing in Subnautica. So you have to avoid them, but if they start to get close, you can use perimeter defense to get them to go away for a short time. For those who would rather have a map to refer to, there are a few online that can offer a helping hand, making the areas mentioned below easier to find. Firstly, it makes the player very tough to kill, thanks to its ability to take a ton of punishment and be quickly repaired if needed. Both begin with a crash on 4546B and require players to fight to stay alive in predator-infested waters. Much like the Seatruck, the Prawn Suit comes with its fair share of upgrades and additional modules. Unsurprisingly, creating vehicles on an alien planet is easier said than done. The Snowfox isn’t as complex as the Seatruck or Prawn Suit and doesn’t have anywhere near the same amount of perks and upgrades. The easiest way to acquire it is by setting up a Scanner Room in the right biome. Only the MK1 depth module is done on the vehicle upgrade console. Much like the Seamoth, the Seatruck has a specific crush depth. It is highly recommended to have a perimeter defense, and hull reinforcement since creatures at both locations will attack you.The main threat you will encounter in the underwater islands is the bone shark which will try to attack you whenever you get near it. The Seatruck starts with a crush depth of 150m, but as detailed below, this can be increased to a whopping 1000m. The Seaglide is also very helpful as the player equips it like an item, rather than it being something that they must find and manually take with them. You have to keep moving until you reach a mini entrance that leads to another large opening.Once you’ve gone through the mini entrance and reached the opening, you have to head west or 1-2 bumps to the right of the west until you eventually come across lava geysers. Luckily, this resource is closer than you think and you don’t have to travel too far from your Lifepod in order to find it. Magnetite can be found in several places across the Subnautica landscape, but it is more abundant in some locations than others. I can’t find anyone saying where to get the MK2/MK3 depth modules. Thankfully, players don’t have to explore the large biomes on their own, as they can dash through the snow on a new vehicle, the Snowfox. But if they get near, then you can use perimeter defense against them to get them to back off.Once you are in the jellyshroom caves, you will need to look northwest and head about 1-2 bumps to the left of the northwest. The vehicle is initially very similar to the Seamoth, but it differentiates itself by letting players add extra attachments, essentially making it a hybrid of the Seamoth and the Cyclops from the original game. This makes the Seatruck an excellent vehicle to prominently use in the mid-game. All I know is that you make them with the Vehicle Upgrade Console - but where are the fragments at? Thankfully, the game’s world is separated into distinct areas that contain their own sets of common resources. Unlike the Seatruck though, the upgrades require fragments to be scanned, while the modules don’t. Plasteel Ingot 2x Enameled Glass Depth Upgrade MK2 - Increases the Seatruck’s maximum crush depth to 650m. Like any great open-world game, Subnautica Below Zero provides minimal hand-holding and guidance, letting players explore the enormous 4546B ocean in any way and any direction that they choose. So although it’s all well and good knowing how to build the Subnautica Below Zero vehicles, tracking down the required materials can be a frustrating challenge. It can be found along the seabed as a single resource, or you can harvest them from large resource deposits. Players can quickly zip between biomes while also having a portable base to craft essential items. Though this offers a great sense of freedom, it can also make it tricky to understand how to progress. Killing enemies in Subnautica Below Zero is well worth the effort, as they don’t respawn. Though it doesn’t provide the player with any extra protection, it greatly increases their speed, making hunting for early-game resources far easier. Then continue straight, and you will eventually come across an area with some holes that are lava geysers in the biome and a few bone sharks that linger around the geysers.Another good place to make a thermal plant farm is in the inactive or active lava zone/lava lakes. Again starting from the coral tube that sticks up out of the water, you have to head about 2-3 bumps to the right of southeast until you reach a hole in the ground that leads to the jellyshroom caves.The main threat you’ll encounter in the caves is the crab snake, which will attack you if you get near them, so you have to avoid them as best as you can.
